Recent Board of Aldermen Action

Ordinance 396: AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A SOLID WASTE DEPOSIT FOR RESIDENTS MOVING INTO THE CITY OF HALLSVILLE AND A DISCOUNT FOR SIGNING UP FOR AUTOMATIC WITHDRAWAL.

Ordinance 397: AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN ADJACENT TERRITORY INTO THE CITY OF HALLSVILLE, MISSOURI.

Ordinance 398: AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF HALLSVILLE TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR THE INVESTMENT OF PUBLIC FUNDS THROUGH THE MISSOURI SECURITIES INVESTMENT PROGRAM.

Ordinance 402 will go into affect on your bill due September 10, 2022

If any bill for trash service (or water and trash service) shall remain due and unpaid after the due date of the 10th, an additional charge of five percent 5% will be added to the bill. All bills not paid before the 21st day of the billing month shall be declared delinquent, a non-payment fee of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) shall be assessed to the account, and the service to the delinquent account shall be discontinued.

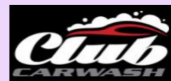
