The beginning of a new Year!

It seems like we just welcomed in 2022 and now the first four months are already gone!

What is over the horizon for Hallsville? In November of 2021, the City went into a contract with the Mid-Missouri Regional Planning Commission as the Project Consultants for a *Comprehensive Plan*. A Comprehensive Plan provides a vision for the future of the community along with the steps that are needed to make that vision a reality. The first part of May you will receive a postcard through the mail that will provide information on how to take a preliminary survey for the Comprehensive Plan. In the coming months there will be continued requests for community input!

Hopefully everyone received their information packet from *Missouri American Water* and have their first sewer bill set up. If you have any questions, their customer service number is 866-430-0820 or you can set up your account at https://www.amwater.com/ If you are a City of Hallsville water customer, then you still pay City Hall for your water and trash. If you are a PWSD#4 water customer, then you still pay City Hall for your trash.

Once a year you have water **primacy fees** added to your City of Hallsville bill, (if you are a City of Hallsville water customer). Effective January 1, 2022 there was a change to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources Primacy Fee structure that affected the amount of the fee. The prorated fee amount for the 2022 annual period was \$4.60 for meters under 1" and \$6.48 for meters over 1" that appeared on your May billing.

The Park Board has also been busy planning out their 2022. Thankfully the weather is finally warming up but now they are just waiting out the rain! The Easter Egg Hunt was a huge success in April despite the wet and muddy park. They have already planned for three Movies in the Park this year. The first is *Clifford the Big Red Dog* on Saturday, May 14th! There will also be a "donation" based garage sale at the park during the City Wide Garage sales from 7:00 a.m. until noon. If anyone wants to donate items please bring them up to City Hall before June 3rd.

The Preliminary Comprehensive Plan Survey lets the Board of Aldermen know what the citizens' vision is. Everyone's voice is important. DEADLINE to do the survey is June 3rd. It is super important to do it online because the results can be compiled faster than sifting through paper copies but if you do not have an email address or access to a computer you can come to City Hall to fill out a paper survey!

This is just the first step of many to complete the Comprehensive Plan and we hope that the citizens of Hallsville will join in the planning for the future of Hallsville.
